FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

I have just returned from a few days retreat in Rome and Assisi that have been a great opportunity to spend time with brother priests and be indulgent with prayer.

During those few days, not only did I pray for the entire parish but, I was also reminded of the beauty of our Catholic faith. Whilst in prayer in Assisi, I was moved by the words of Christ to St Francis, "go and rebuild my church which is falling down!"

I was struck by the reality that that call to Francis is a call that each of us receives through our baptisms. We are called not necessarily to rebuild our physical churches (although that is helpful!) but to constantly rebuild our relationship with Christ through the Eucharist and Confession.
