FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

We continue to listen to St John's Gospel this Sunday and hear how Jesus prays to His Father before His arrest and crucifixion. He prays for the same strength and protection He has received from the Father to now be given to His disciples who have already faced rejection and ridicule, with more to come!

The same protection that Jesus invokes on His disciples is exactly the same that He invokes upon us today.

Jesus does not tell His disciples (and by extension us!) that we are not to be in the world but, rather, He tells them that they are not to be of the world.

In other words, as followers of Christ, we are called to be missionaries of the good news of our salvation. We will face obstacles and ridicule but, today's Gospel reminds us that the Lord will be there with us to face whatever comes our way!

SAINT OF THE WEEK Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini

Frances Xavier Cabrini was born in Italy on July 15th 1850.

She is often known as Mother Cabrini and was the founder of the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This was one of the first missionary congregations run by women alone.

Mother Cabrini was pivotal in helping to support immigrants to the United States and providing them with education and medical care when no one else would.

She died in 1917.

Mother Cabrini was the first US citizen to be canonised a saint on July 7th 1946. She is the patron saint of immigrants.
